Sponsor's Guidelines

The role of the sponsor in the Cursillo movement is twofold. First, a sponsor seeks appropriate people to encourage attending a Cursillo weekend. Second, a sponsor responds prayerfully to associates who volunteer to attend a Cursillo weekend.

The role of a sponsor begins with assessing a person's potential for Christian leadership. Once the sponsor determines that a person will be a good Participant, the sponsor prays for the Participant, helps submit the applications, helps find funding, if needed, helps make household arrangements (who will watch the children, feed the pets, etc.) and answers questions as fully as possible (since we are not a secretive entity). The sponsor transports the Participant to and from the weekend, helps the new Cursillista find a reunion group, takes the new Cursillista to the Day of Deeper Understanding or Fourth Day Workshop/Seminar held a few weeks after the weekend, and otherwise gives personal palanca. The sponsor also sees that the new Cursillista gets to an Ultreya after the weekend.

Should the sponsor discover some impediment which would make the Participant unsuitable, she/he should *not* let the Participant go to the weekend! A Participant struggling with emotional problems, financial distress, marriage difficulties, unexpected unemployment, etc., is too distracted to benefit from the talks and lessons of a weekend. Moreover, such a distracted person will intrude on other Participants' participation in the weekend.

Sponsoring a Participant is time consuming and a blessing. Sponsoring a Participant is a significant commitment of energy and attention. Please do not take the responsibility lightly.

Sponsors and Participants must understand that the North Carolina Episcopal Cursillo is a movement of the Episcopal Church, under the authority of the Episcopal Bishop of North Carolina. **All Participants must be Episcopalians.** All religious teaching on the Cursillo weekend is consistent with the teaching of the Episcopal Church. All worship during the Cursillo weekend is from the Episcopal Church's Book of Common Prayer. All baptized persons who believe in the real presence of our Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist may receive communion on the Cursillo weekend.

Sponsoring a Participant

1. Explain Cursillo to your Participant, answer questions, and help the Participant complete the application. Be sure that the Participant's clergy approves of the application.
2. Complete the Sponsor's Form (Page 1). If financial aid is needed, fill in the necessary information on the Sponsor's form.
3. Mail the Participant's application, \$59 deposit (or complete payment \$175.00), and Sponsor's Form. Nothing will happen until **all** the paperwork is received.

Sponsors:

- Pray for guidance.
- Know the goals and methods of Cursillo.
- Live the message of the weekend.
- Know the Participant well.
- Speak to God about the Participant - before speaking to the Participant about Cursillo.
- Explain that Cursillo expects a Christian recommitment.
- Explain the Fourth Day and its plan of continuing Christian fellowship.
- Make sure the Participant is going because he or she wants to, not as a favor to you.
- Invite the Participant to an Ultreya before attending the weekend.
- Arrange transportation for the Participant to and from the weekend.

- Support the Participant with palanca and at the Closing.
 - Take the Participant to the Fourth Day Workshop after the weekend.
 - See that the Participant finds a permanent group reunion and is introduced to their local Ultreya.
 - Make sure the Participant understands that alcoholic beverages are forbidden on the weekend.

Participants:

- Desire to grow as a Christian.
- Be someone whose ideas and attitudes influence others.
- Have a willingness to listen, a friendly attitude, and a predisposition to change.
- Understand that Cursillo is not just a weekend, but is a pattern of more effective living.
- Is mature, responsible, and able to make his or her own decisions.

Financial Aid

If necessary, financial aid is available to assist with the fee. *It is your responsibility, as a sponsor, to explore potential sources of financial aid for all or part of the weekend's cost, prior to asking for assistance from NC Cursillo's Bishops' Fund.* These sources include your personal resources, other individuals, group reunion, local Ultreya, clergy, parish, and parish organizations. As the Secretariat believes that there is a greater benefit when there is a personal investment, Participants are encouraged to pay at least the deposit (\$59) from their own resources.
